The WPF Mountain Region Chapter (www.mountainwpcf.com) was founded in 2015 as a chapter of the national organization, Women in Public Finance (www.wpfc.com). The Chapter covers the states of Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Utah and Wyoming. Our goals are to advance leadership opportunities for women by fostering relationships and providing educational activities and forums. Participants include state and local government issuers, not-for-profit issuers, investment bankers, attorneys, financial advisors, rating agency analysts, trust officers, and municipal market investors who work in the State. The Mountain Region Chapter is governed by an up to a 12-member volunteer Executive Council comprised of women from diverse professions within the public finance industry and locations. Each year the Executive Council selects new members to join based on availability of openings, geographic location, profession, etc.

- Your name and contact information
- A brief description of your work experience, particularly work in the field of public finance (you may attach a resume instead)
- Whether you are applying for a 2-year position (2 openings) or 3-year position (4 openings)
- A list of other boards, committees, professional organizations, community or philanthropic groups in which you are or have been involved
- The reasons you would like to serve on the Executive Council and the skills and resources you believe you can contribute to the success of the organization. Please also share what committee(s) you are most interested in serving (Marketing, Programs, Sponsorship or Regional). - A statement of understanding of the time commitment to the Executive Council
